Insurance company forms including review of records (disability, travel, time off)	\$140 - \$190

Pneumonia Vaccine	\$30 (if <65)
Vitamin B12	\$30

TB skin test	\$45
Whooping cough vaccine	\$45
Hep B vaccine	\$40/dose (3 doses)
Hep A	\$65/dose (2 doses)

Procedures (including tray fee of \$40)

Milium extraction	\$40 for one, \$75 for multiple
Liquid nitrogen	\$75 for first lesion, \$25 per subsequent lesion if > 1 lesion
Mole excision	\$150 - \$350 depending on sutures/location

Missed appointment	\$40/visit, \$50/pap, \$80/physical (as per MSP fees)
Transfer of records-basic	\$45
